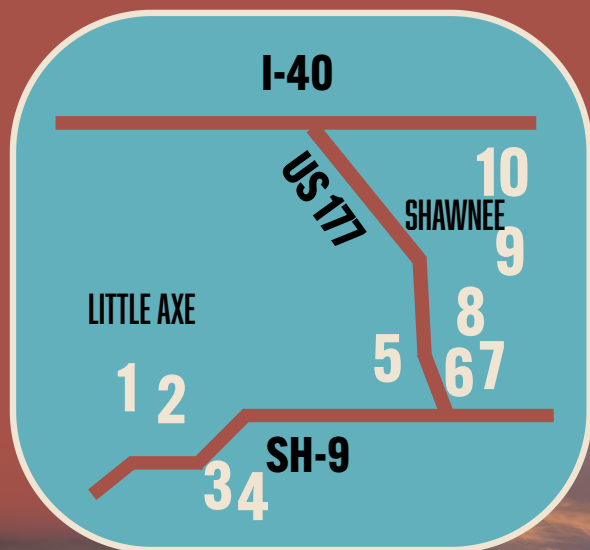

The goal of the Wi Si Ka To Wi is to provide prevention, treatment, MAT (medication assisted treatment), harm reduction and recovery services with respect, understanding and compassion .

The TOR WI SI KA TO WI | Be Well

project is part of a community support system. For the Indigenous population facing the opioid and stimulant crisis this project provides access to critical services like prevention, treatment, MAT (medication assisted treatment), recovery assistance and overdose prevention.

ESSENTIAL REQUIREMENTS FOR RECOVERY AND TREATMENT SERVICES

- Have a substance use disorder (SUD) involving opioids or stimulants like methamphetamine
- Enrolled citizen of a U.S. federally recognized tribe/nation
- Proof of tribe/nation enrollment/citizenship like a Certificate Degree of Indian Blood (CDIB)
- Established patient with the Absentee Shawnee Health care system
- Reside in the State of Oklahoma in one of the following counties: Cleveland, Lincoln, Logan, Oklahoma, Pottawatomie

TREATMENT SERVICES

When you or a loved one are ready for treatment, we can help:

- explore treatment options
- assist with payment for inpatient treatment centers (subject to available funds)
- transport to/from treatment facilities
- with applying for insurance
- refer you to therapies effective in treating persons with a substance use disorder (SUD)
- connect you with Medication Assisted Treatment (MAT) services

RECOVERY SERVICES

Embracing support is vital in your recovery journey. We can provide support like:

- exploring pathways to recovery
- payment assistance with sobriety/recovery housing (subject to available funds)
- limited transportation for recovery-related engagements
- clothing stipend for employment purposes
- connect you with Medication Assisted Treatment (MAT) services

OVERDOSE PREVENTION

To reduce overdoses and ultimately save lives, the TOR WI SI KA TO WI | Be Well project provides free narcan and fentanyl test strips in ten locations. Four are in Little Axe - Norman, OK and six are in Shawnee, OK.

PREVENTION

To effect positive change we share information to minimize the impact of substance use on Native individuals, children, families and communities. Ways we effect change:

- weave in positive cultural values and practices in trainings and teachings
- organize and facilitate outreach to expand awareness of our project as a resource
- encourage the community to identify their strengths and be aware of their vulnerabilities
- work with school aged youth to enhance resilience
- create educational materials
- work with tribal population to collect data to ensure we meet community needs

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
